Appalachian Mountain Brewery, Inc. operates (3) three Wholly-Owned Subsidiaries:

1. Appalachian Mountain Brewery, LLC.

2. FarmToFlame, LLC.

3. Hard Mountain Cider, LLC.

1. Appalachian Mountain Brewery, LLC., the Official Brewery of the Appalachian Mountains, not only makes seriously delicious craft beer, but focuses its business model on community, sustainability and philanthropy. In 2014 AMB was chosen as winner of Brewbound’s Start Up Brewery Challenge and ultimately won Startup Brewery of the Year. AMB was selected to compete, along with 8 other startup breweries and cider companies from all over the country. The Company’s CEO gave a presentation outlining AMB's core values and goals for the next several years. AMB presented the “1st Revolution” a collaboration beer between AMB & Blood Sweat and Gears for the panel to sample and provide feedback and analysis. AMB won the popular vote with over 34% of all votes and the judges picked AMB as the winner of Brewbound's “Start Up Brewery Challenge 2014 Boston”. In 2014 AMB has won a silver medal for its Smokey Mountain Schwartz Beer and a Bronze medal for its Crooked Common in the 2014 U.S. Open Beer Championships. Additionally, AMB won two Gold Medals and won the overall categories in the 2013 United States Open Beer Championship for its Honey Badger Blonde Ale and California Common. AMB competed against the biggest and best breweries from around the world where over 3,000 beers competed in 81 categories for aroma, appearance, mouth feel, flavor and overall impression. Appalachian Mountain Brewery, located at 3,333 feet elevation atop the Appalachian Mountain Range in Boone, NC, is certified by the NC GreenTravel Initiative, a program that recognizes state travel-related businesses that employ healthy environmental practices. AMB is within minutes of world-class destinations such as Grandfather Mountain, Tweetsie Railroad, Beech Mountain, Sugar Mountain, Appalachian Ski Resorts and the Three-Time National Football Champions Appalachian State University.

2. FarmToFlame, LLC, is a wholly owned subsidiary and its primary function is to service AMB. It is a food truck that features a unique wood fired oven in the truck. This allows AMB to enhance its experience for customers with a casual dining experience that balances innovation and sustainability. Currently open 6 days a week for dinner at AMB, Farm To Flame has plans to expand into lunch and potentially looking for franchising in 2015 as well as begin a wholesale beer infused dough operation. Appalachian Mountain Brewery, LLC:

The Company has conducted operations as a craft brewery and tap room from February 14, 2013 to present in Boone, NC. In 2014 AMB increased its capacity over 200 percent to meet current demand. AMB has begun distributing beer into On/Off Premise accounts in North Carolina by utilizing self-distribution and will select a wholesale distributor in Q4 2014. Additionally, Mike Pruitt, CEO of Chanticleer Holdings, (Nasdaq: HOTR), has agreed to distribute AMB products into new locations including but not limited to the restaurants it manages including certain Hooters, American Roadside Burgers, and Just Fresh locations it owns. AMB won Brewbound.com "Startup Brewery Challenge 2014 Boston" hosted by Brewbound and Craft Brewers Alliance (Nasdaq: BREW) and experienced an all-expenses-paid trip to Portland, Oregon to become Widmer Brothers Brewing "Brother for a Day." AMB will craft a new collaboration beer with Widmer Brothers, take an extensive tour of the company's pilot and production breweries, participate in Widmer Brothers Brewing daily taste panel and learn from the company's sales, marketing, graphics, quality assurance and packaging departments.

Sponsored by Craft Brew Alliance, (NASDAQ: BREW), the contest gave nine beer and cider companies the opportunity to showcase their products and business plans in front of a judging panel of expert brewers, marketers and retailers, as well as an audience of 175 brewing industry professionals. Sean Spiegelman, the CEO and Founder of Appalachian Mountain Brewery, was chosen over eight other participants with his diversified approach to business, one that relies on cause-based marketing and includes beer and cider production as well as a food truck service.

The brewery operates a 3,700 square foot facility located at 163 Boone Creek Drive, Boone, NC 28607. AMB currently leases from a corporation wholly owned by our CEO, Mr. Sean Spiegelman. Our taproom offers 16 beers on tap that are brewed on site. AMB brews seasonally as well has multiple flagships. We serve at the seated bar and our indoor tables. We provide a 120-foot outdoor bar and a covered porch for additional seating to relax on sunny afternoons or enclosed with heat in the winter. Our brew system is a 10-barrel, 310 gallon, JV Northwest all-American made system. It’s made of high-grade stainless steel, the standard for breweries across

the world for its ease of use and durability. It's accompanied by (7) 20- barrel jacketed fermenters and (3) 20-barrel jacket bright tanks. Our facility has a 5KW array of solar panels to offset electricity along with a recapturing system to save water in the brew process. Additionally, AMB filed with T.T.B for its license to open Hard Mountain Cider, LLC. a wholly owned subsidiary of Appalachian Mountain Brewery, Inc. Hard Mountain Cider, LLC has leased 3,300 square feet of operation space to begin production of hard cider using North Carolina apples. HMC, LLC has been officially certified by ASAP (Appalachian Sustainable Agriculture Project) www.asapconnections.org www.appalachiangrown.org as a AG Partner.
