Orca Touchscreen's business is the design, production, sale, distribution, service and refurbishment of touchscreen devices, including smartphones and tablets. The Company is working with partners in developing countries to establish semi knock down (SKD) assembly factories to produce smartphones, tablets and other touchscreen devices for sale in that country's growing market. "SKD" means "semi-knock down" and refers to an assembly method whereby kits of partially-assembled components are imported and assembled into finished products. Orca's business involves establishing joint ventures in which SKD kits are imported and assembled by a local workforce in a developing country for sale, distribution, service and refurbishment into the emerging market of smartphone and tablet users in that developing country.

Generally, in the past month, the Issuer: (a) continued to work towards a definitive joint venture agreement regarding Sollen-Mobile, SA ("Sollen Guatemala") and its smartphone SKD assembly factory in Guatemala; (b) continued to work towards a letter of intent with Solucel, S.A. of Guatemala regarding the distribution of touchscreen devices in Central America; and (c) continued to negotiate with potential joint venture partners to establish smartphone and tablet SKD assembly factories in various countries throughout the world.
