Nature of business

Business Development

The corporation company was incorporated on August 21, 2001 in the State of Nevada, USA. Its financial year end is on December 31.

In December 2007, 3090-8925 Quebec Inc. acquired control of Canadian Blue Gold, Inc. from its then principal shareholder Mr. Allain Barriere. 3090-8925 Quebec, Inc. is owned by Mrs Francine Lavoie and is also controlling shareholder of Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc. a Canadian company operating a 17 250 sq. ft. bottling plant on one of the best natural spring water known in North America, located at Saint-Elie-de-Caxton, Quebec. Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc. is the Canadian leader in the market for high end and personalized natural spring water private label and promotional items products.

Previous to the change of control, the Corporation obtained majority shareholders vote to proceed with a share capital reorganization resulting in the reduction of its authorized capital to 500,000,000 shares and consolidation (reverse-split) of its shares on a 300 for 1 basis.

The Corporation was also granted an exclusive license for the US market by 3090-8925 Quebec, Inc. and Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc. for valued received considerations, in the process 3090-8925 Quebec, Inc. acquired 22 million shares of the company.

The first stream of the licence is related to the marketing, sales and distribution of the brands and products developed by Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc. On April 20, 2007, Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc. received a prestigious award with 2 stars from the IQTI of Belgium for the Superior Taste of its natural spring water. Since then the demand for their water has risen.

The second stream will be to sell sub licences for marketing, sales and distribution of the private labels products and programs developed by Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc. BOREAL will be able to offer high end products to clients looking for innovation and asking for more than a standard product. The company has the most impressive and complete selection of unique bottles, labels and caps in the whole industry of private label water.

The third stream will be for BOREAL to develop certain market itself and to propose their personalized products not only in the bottled water trade but in the promotional item market.

Business of Issuer

The company is in the development stages.

3090-8925 Quebec, Inc. has acquired control of the company to actively develop the US market for high end and personalized natural spring water private label and promotional items products, with the intent of leveraging on the existing business activity of Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc., its business, operating and distribution contacts developed over the last 10 years.

BOREAL Water Collection, Inc. wants to become the leading high end producer of the most prestigious and luxurious private labelled water for North America. Its affiliation with Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc., which earned a leadership position in Canada over the last decade in the production of high end private labelled water, will permit BOREAL to enter the market rapidly due to the know-how and expertise

acquired from Sources Saint-Élie. In 2007, Saint-Élie was awarded one of the most prestigious prizes from the Institute of Quality and Taste International. BOREAL is committed to providing their customers with the highest quality private label bottled water products at affordable prices supported by an outstanding level of product selection and customer service. Its offer of labels and bottles shapes and size is the most impressive in the market. In today's health-conscious society private label bottled water is the perfect vehicle to promote corporate image. Bottled water has become an excellent promotional item. Because BOREAL can provide a turn-key product, it is able to service almost every kind of corporate customers either as a promotional item or as bottled water.

BOREAL Water Collection wants to develop a national network of bottled water production facilities through acquisitions, joint ventures or by granting sub licences to selected production plants.

BOREAL Water Collection with its exclusive offer and its private labelling know-how will expand by selling distribution licenses to established distributors as well as developing itself some national corporate accounts. BOREAL intend to position itself as the leader of high end private label water. Because of the unique selection already available through Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc., penetration of the US market should be rapid.

As an affiliate of Les Sources Saint-Élie Inc., the Corporation will operate as a separate independent business concern. The initial development phase will consist in activating existing relationships with prospective clients and distributors to generate revenues. At such stage, the Corporation will order and subcontract products bottling to its Canadian affiliate. At the appropriate stage the Corporation will proceed with the acquisition of at least one existing spring water source in the US and produce from such location in addition to its access to the Canadian affiliate facilities.

As of the date of change of control the Corporation had no revenues. The Corporation shall then be considered at development stage and the new management believes that it is unlikely that the Corporation will benefit from any of the past initiatives of former management or shareholders or capital spent into any such initiatives. The capital investments and any residual value of such still part of the Corporation's financial statements as of the date of acquisition have been written-off.

In its activities in the water bottling business, the Corporation has to comply with different states and federal regulations regarding food products and spring water consumables. The products of the Canadian affiliate Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc. are already qualified in several States in the US. As applicable, the Corporation will proceed to qualify all of its products accordingly to applicable rules and regulations.

At this time, the Corporation has five (5) employees, of which three (3) are temporarily provided by the Canadian affiliate Les Sources Saint-Elie, Inc.

Nature of products or services offered

BOREAL Water Collection, Inc. specializes in producing high end personalized bottled water and custom bottled water for any size of company, anywhere. BOREAL offers personalized bottled water in many formats with spring water, sparkling spring water and custom formulated water. Custom bottled water has many applications. Anywhere you see brand water being sold you could see your own custom bottled water. Luxury hotels, restaurants, lounges, clubs, high-end hospitality, food service venues and mass wholesale initiatives are several of the industries we can supply with our private labeled bottled water. With sales of bottled water including the personalized variety at an all time high, BOREAL provides companies with the opportunity to capitalize on this emerging trend.

The bottled water industry could be considered as oligopolistic, since only six companies control nearly 85% of the market. These players produce millions of litres per year and fight for market shares, increase their plants capacity and reduce their selling price, essentially to the large retail stores. This creates an opportunity they do not address. By concentrating on the large retailers they set their production for high speed, high volume and they forget the smaller retailers and the private label opportunities.

By gearing its production line to produce for small recurrent but high margin orders, the Corporation avoids costly price wars and brand positioning and is able to reach profitability at volumes unknown to the industry. To such flexible production, the Corporation benefits from Saint-Elie's design department, resulting in its own proprietary bottles shapes and forms, are enhancing its offering in the private label and promotional items market, with more value. The design department also produces labels that fits with

the private label and promotional items market, since providing the client (directly or through resellers) with a complete offering and finished product, from getting the initial order to delivery, the client approving and buying the labels, Saint-Elie taking charge of allocating the print job and bottling for the client. This approach bring a high value added to Saint-Elie sales, provide the client with a one-stop ordering process and appeared to be a success with the private label and promotional items market.

The Corporation will essentially concentrate its sales approach to private label clients to an « all-in » or "turn-key" product, i.e. BOREAL dealing with label conception and design, allocating the print job, bottling/production and delivery to client. A majority of clients do want and choose this option since they are smaller and willing to pay the premium associated with quality, piece of mind, design/printing and trucking all at once.

The nature and extent of the issuer's facilities

At this stage, the Corporation has no production facilities in the US. It will initially order and subcontract products bottling to its Canadian affiliate. At the appropriate stage the Corporation will proceed with the acquisition of at least one spring water source in the US and produce from such location in addition to its access to the Canadian affiliate facilities.

A. Plan of Operation.
