Dear Mr. Natario:

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) received your permit determination request on October 7, 2014 for the processing of gold tailings at the Congress Mine in Congress, Arizona.

According to the Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-2-302.B.2:

- 2. "...A Class II permit shall be required for:
 - A person to begin actual construction of or operate any stationary source that emits or has the uncontrolled potential to emit significant quantities of regulated NSR pollutants;

In addition, according to A.A.C. R18-2-302.B.3 and 4

- "...A Class II permit shall be required for any of the activities that would require a 3. registration under subsections (B)(4)(b) and (c)."
- " registration shall be required for: 4.
 - "A person to begin actual construction of or operate any stationary source subject (b) to a standard under Section 111 of the Act,..."
 - (c) "A person to begin actual construction of or operate any stationary source subject to a standard under Section 112 of the Act,..."

Based on the Department's review of the information submitted, it has been determined that your facility is not subject to any standards or other requirements under Sections 111 or 112 of the Clean Air Act which would require a permit and does not have the potential to emit air pollutants above significance levels as defined in A.A.C. R18-2-101.130.a. The Department has determined that the facility does not

require an Air Quality Control Permit at this time. Please note that this does not exempt your facility from any other federal or local regulations.
