Revocation Order

**Buscar Company
(formerly Colorado Gold Mines, Inc.)**

Section 171 of the *Securities Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 418

- ¶ 1 On January 23, 2013, the Executive Director ordered, under section 164(1) of the Act, that all trading in the securities of Colorado Gold Mines, Inc. cease until it files the required records referred to in the order and the Executive Director revokes the cease trade order.
- ¶ 2 At the time of the cease trade order, Colorado Gold Mines, Inc. was an OTC reporting issuer in British Columbia under Multilateral Instrument 51-105 *Issuers Quoted in the U.S. Over-the-Counter Markets*.
- ¶ 3 On July 28, 2014, the Executive Director varied the cease trade order to reflect that Colorado Gold Mines, Inc. changed its name to Buscar Oil, Inc.
- ¶ 4 On October 4, 2016, the Executive Director varied the cease trade order to reflect that Buscar Oil, Inc. changed its name to Buscar Company.
- ¶ 5 Buscar Company applied to the Executive Director under section 171 of the Act to revoke the cease trade order, and represented that:
1. its business has not been directed or administered; and
 2. no promotional activities have been carried on
- in or from British Columbia since at least June 15, 2015.
- ¶ 6 Buscar Company has ceased to be an OTC reporting issuer in British Columbia.
- ¶ 7 The Executive Director, considering that it would not be prejudicial to the public interest, revokes the cease trade order under section 171 of the Act.
