1. Pursuant to an Agreement dated 06/01/2019, Triage Microcap would loan funds to the Company for expenses relating to bringing the Company back in good standing and other expenses. The loan would be convertible at market price into Common Shares of the Company. A total of 5,105,000 shares were issued at the then current market price of \$0.0011 in repayment of the loan on 6/1/2019 and 9/28/2019 in different names at the request of the note holder.
2. On 3/31/20221, Shareholders of Sentry Petroleum agreed to transfer shares to parties of Relief Naturals to consummate the acquisition. The amount of shares transferred and/or created to complete the acquisition is 68,000,000 common capital stock. Part of the acquisition agreement entitles management

We were an exploration stage company engaged in the assessment, acquisition, exploration and development of oil, gas, and other hydrocarbon properties in Australia and other regions in Austral Asia. We have suspended our

continued operations due to lack of funding and investments resulting in a failure to carryout exploration work programs on the properties underlying our permits.

In 2019, the Board of Directors voted to seek new investment and equity partners. The Company believes this new direction in the Cannabis and CBD Oils sector was timely and in the best interest of the shareholders. The Company looked to hire new management and secure new investment opportunities. The Company hired new management and entered into a share exchange agreement with Relief Naturals, Inc.

Today, we have developed a strategic plan and identified target acquisitions that will enable the Company to bring together complementary businesses that can deliver a vertically integrated solution in this exciting market. We target the phyto functional and forward medicinal market to create synergies.

Since the legalization of Cannabis, there has been increasing research to back up the observed benefits of CBD, which has, in turn, increased awareness of the various health benefits. The company plans to capitalize on this market sector through acquisitions.

Psilocybin

Psilocybin acts as Serotonin 2 receptor agonists. Research has shown it has potential to treat a range of psychiatric and behavioural disorders, including:

Depression

Obsessive Compulsive Disorder Quitting Smoking

Alcohol Addiction

Cocaine Addiction

Cluster Headaches

Cancer-related psychological distress End of Life psychological distress

Much like Cannabis was perceived in the general public, Mushrooms 'shrooms, which contain the active ingredient psilocybin, are following a similar trajectory from the psychedelic 60s to legalized medicinal health supplement.

CBD

CBD has seen a dramatic shift both in terms of legalization and recognized therapeutic uses. The increase in large scale trials and research will only serve to grow this market and identify future uses of medicinal CBD.

Cannabidiol (CBD) is an active ingredient in Cannabis-derived from hemp or cannabis plants. CBD, or cannabidiol, is non-intoxicating and one of the more than 540 phytochemicals¹ found in Hemp and Cannabis plants. Increasing data suggests CBD may help treat conditions like pain, insomnia, and anxiety. CBD appears to work on the endocannabinoid system, the bodies signalling network. Historically cannabis strains have been developed with a focus on high THC and on illicit growing, rather than larger scale growth. For the medicinal markets, as the large- scale research is completed, there is more of a need for strains with specific cannabinoids to meet the medical requirements.

NOTE 1 - BUSINESS

Sentry Petroleum Ltd. (the “Company”), was incorporated under the laws of the State of Nevada on Feb 23, 2006. The Company was later domesticated in the State of Wyoming on January 27, 2020. The Company is involved in the acquisition, development and exploration of Oil and Gas properties.

On 03/31/2021 the Company entered into an Agreement to acquire 100% outstanding shares of Relief Naturals Ltd, a company based out of Canada specializing in products made of Cannabis and CBD oils. Statements for the period ending 05/31/2021 reflect the combined Financial Statements of Sentry Petroleum and Relief Naturals Ltd.

NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of presentation

The Company’s unaudited financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (“U.S. GAAP”). The accompanying unaudited financial statements reflect all adjustments, consisting of only normal recurring items, which, in the opinion of management, are not necessarily indicative of the results to be expected for the full year ending February 28, 2022. Comparative Financial Statements for the period ending May 31, 2020 of the previous year were filed on or about 07/28/2021.

Use of estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

Cash and cash equivalents

The Company considers all highly liquid investments purchased with original maturities of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

Concentration of Credit Risk

The Company has no significant off-balance-sheet concentrations of credit risk such as foreign exchange contracts, options contracts or other foreign hedging arrangements.

Revenue Recognition

The Company recognizes revenue when there is persuasive evidence of an arrangement, delivery has occurred, the fee is determinable, collectability is reasonably assured and there are no significant remaining performance obligations.

Employment Agreement

There are no Employment Agreements with any employees of the Company.

Income Taxes

Income taxes are accounted for under the assets and liability method. Current income taxes are provided in accordance with the laws of the respective taxing authorities. Deferred income taxes are provided for the estimated future tax consequences attributable to differences between the financial statement carrying amounts of existing assets and liabilities and their respective tax bases and operating loss and tax credit carry-forwards. Deferred tax assets and liabilities are measured using enacted tax rates in effect for the year in which those

temporary differences are expected to be recovered or settled. Deferred tax assets are reduced by a valuation allowance when, in the opinion of management, it is more likely than not that some portion or all of the deferred tax assets will be realized.

NOTE 3 - GOING CONCERN

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared assuming that the Company will continue as a going concern, which contemplates the realization of assets and the discharge of liabilities in the normal course of business for the foreseeable future. As of May 31, 2021, the Company has a nominal revenue generating operation generating \$454 in sales, and an accumulated deficit of \$6,154,207. The Company's ability to raise additional capital through the future issuances of common stock and/or debt financing is unknown. The obtainment of additional financing, the successful development of the Company's contemplated plan of operations, and its transition, ultimately, to the attainment of profitable operations are necessary for the Company to continue operations. These conditions and the ability to successfully resolve these factors raise substantial doubt about the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. The financial statements of the Company do not include any adjustments that may result from the outcome of these aforementioned uncertainties.

NOTE 4 – OTHER ITEMS

1. Legal Proceedings - The company is not currently involved in any legal proceedings.
2. The company has marginal net operating loss carry forwards for federal income tax purposes estimated at about \$6,154,207 through May 31, 2021. Due to the company's issuance of stock, the company's use of its existing loss carry-forwards may be restricted under Section 382 of the Internal Revenue Code.

As on May 31, 2021, the Company has no Related Party Transactions.

NOTE 6 – COMMON STOCK

During the year ended February 28, 2021, the Company has not issued any new shares of common stock. During the year, the Company cancelled 2,140,000 common stock of employees following their termination. The cancelled stock was valued at \$0.0021 based on end of day share price data from eoddata.com for an adjustment of \$4,494.

During the current year, the Company has issued 68,000,000 shares to secure the purchase of Relief Naturals Ltd.
