Updated Acquisition Information:

On July 1, 2025, JP 3E Holdings, Inc. (JPTE) (JP3E) completed its acquisition of 100% of MetaRock, Inc., which now operates as a wholly owned subsidiary. We are currently awaiting MetaRock's financials and patent portfolio to finalize consolidation into JPTE's financial statements, which we anticipate receiving in the near future.

On August 8, 2025, JP 3E Holdings, Inc. (JPTE) (JP3E) announced the acquisition of certified and appraised rare artwork assets valued at over \$300 million from Khan Gallery. The consideration for this acquisition consisted of 150,000,000 shares (restricted) of JPTE common stock valued at \$2.00 per share.

Of the approved consideration, 100,000,000 shares (restricted) have been issued to date. The remaining 50,000,000 shares will no longer be issued or outstanding, adjusting the effective share valuation to \$3.00 per share for the \$300 million in Khan Gallery assets.

The \$300 million certified valuation will serve as the cost basis for accounting purposes for the agreed 100,000,000 shares (restricted) of JPTE (JP3E). However, the actual market value of the acquired artwork is materially higher than \$300 Million and will be updated in future financials to be reflected as appreciated value on the Balance Sheet, recognized immediately as an increase in Shareholders' Equity.

Portions of the artwork have been published for additional review and verification under the JPTE Research section on OTC Markets.

The certification and appraisal process was conducted by Ho Kyung-bin, the Ceramic Science Appraisal Board, and the Northeast Asia Humsae Art Appraisal Center. Scientific authentication utilized the 6th Rock Yangam Quantum Appraisal Device, which provides a 99% accuracy rate in determining production periods, supported by high-resolution imaging through facility-grade systems and smartphones. Additionally, the GEM Identification Certificate for the Jade Phoenix Chairs and Side Table was issued by appraiser Guo Yu-chuan.
