On October 31, 2024, the Company entered into an Agreement and Plan of Merger with Automated Water Solutions (“AWS”). AWS subsequently renegeed on the terms of the agreement and requested to unwind the transaction. On March 31, 2025, the parties executed a Rescission Agreement and General Mutual Release, pursuant to which the merger agreement and the transactions contemplated thereby were rescinded and deemed void in their entirety as of October 31, 2024. Any book-entry share records associated with the contemplated transaction were reversed and did not result in issued and outstanding shares.

Because the parties treated the transaction as void ab initio, management concluded that the rescinded transaction had no impact on the Company’s financial position, results of operations, or cash flows.

On March 23rd, 2023, the District Court of Clark County, Nevada, entered an “Order Granting Application for Appointment of Custodian” of Belisarian Holdings, LLC., as Custodian of Zhuding International Limited. (case number: A23-866222-P). Pursuant to the aforementioned order, Belisarian Holdings, LLC. may take any actions on behalf of Zhuding International Limited., which are reasonable, prudent, or for the benefit of Zhuding International Limited., including but not limited to, issuing shares of stock, issuing new classes of stock, and entering into contracts on behalf of Zhuding International Limited. Belisarian Holdings, LLC., pursuant to

the order, is also responsible for meeting all requirements under the Nevada Charter. The custodianship was discharged on September 29, 2023.

On May 28, 2024, the District Court of Clark County appointed Belisarian Holdings, LLC, as the receiver of Zhuding International Limited. The court subsequently granted Belisarian Holdings LLC's motion to bar all unasserted claims and discharged the receivership on August 21, 2024.

**NOTE 1 – ORGANIZATION AND NATURE OF OPERATIONS**

Zhuding International Limited (the “Company”) is a Nevada corporation with a fiscal year end of December 31. The Company’s common stock is quoted on the OTC Pink Market under the symbol “ZHUD.”

Prior to 2023, the Company had discontinued its business operations and failed to take steps to formally dissolve or liquidate. During that period, the Company did not maintain compliance with certain Nevada statutory requirements, including filing required reports with the Nevada Secretary of State, paying annual franchise taxes, and holding annual meetings of stockholders. As a result, the Company’s corporate charter was revoked.

On February 24, 2023, Belisarian Holdings, LLC (“Belisarian”), a shareholder of the Company, filed a petition in the District Court of Clark County, Nevada (Case No. A-23-866222-P), seeking appointment as custodian of the Company pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes. On March 23, 2023, the court entered an order appointing Belisarian as custodian (the “Custodian”) and authorizing it to take actions reasonably necessary to restore the Company’s corporate existence and compliance, including issuing shares, designating new classes of stock, entering into contracts, and reinstating the Company’s charter.

On March 28, 2023, the Company filed a Certificate of Reinstatement with the Nevada Secretary of State, reinstating its corporate charter and appointing a registered agent. The Custodian was unable to recover historical accounting records from prior management; however, shareholder records were obtained, and the Company’s outstanding common shares were reflected in the accompanying unaudited financial statements for prior periods.

On September 29, 2023, the District Court of Clark County, Nevada, entered an order discharging the custodianship and approving the cancellation of certain shares. As of that date, Dilan Gonzalez serves as the sole director of the Company.

The Company was originally incorporated in Nevada on December 18, 2006, under the name Van Gold Resources Inc. and changed its name to Zhuding International Limited in July 2016.

**NOTE 2 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

*Basis of Presentation*

The accompanying unaudited financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America (“U.S. GAAP”) and are presented in U.S. dollars. The Company is an alternative reporting company and is not subject to SEC periodic reporting requirements.

*Use of Estimates*

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with U.S. GAAP requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect reported amounts and disclosures. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

*Related-Party Transactions*

Related parties include shareholders, officers, directors, and entities under common control. Transactions with related parties are disclosed when material.

*Fair Value of Financial Instruments*

Due to their short-term nature, the carrying amounts of the Company's financial instruments, including cash and any short-term liabilities, approximate fair value.

#### *Income Taxes*

The Company accounts for income taxes using the asset-and-liability method. Deferred tax assets are recognized for net operating loss carryforwards and other temporary differences and are offset by a valuation allowance when management determines that realization is not more likely than not. As of March 31, 2026, and 2025, the Company maintained a full valuation allowance and did not record any income tax expense.

#### *Recently Issued Accounting Pronouncements*

Management has reviewed recently issued accounting standards and determined that none had a material impact on the Company's financial statements.

### **NOTE 3 – GOING CONCERN**

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared assuming the Company will continue as a going concern. As of March 31, 2026, the Company had no revenues, an accumulated deficit of approximately \$456,182, and limited cash resources.

These conditions raise substantial doubt about the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. The financial statements do not include any adjustments that might result from the outcome of this uncertainty. Management intends to seek additional capital through equity issuances or other financing arrangements; however, there can be no assurance that such financing will be available.

### **NOTE 4 – RELATED-PARTY TRANSACTIONS**

During the periods presented, Belisarian Holdings, LLC ("Belisarian"), a majority shareholder of the Company, paid operating and professional expenses on behalf of the Company. The Company recognized the related expenses in the accompanying statements of operations in the periods incurred.

In 2023, the Company issued a share of preferred stock to Belisarian with an aggregate stated value of \$40,000. The preferred stock issuance was intended to compensate Belisarian for operating and professional expenses incurred on the Company's behalf, up to the stated value of the preferred stock.

As of March 31, 2026, the Company issued to Belisarian Holdings, LLC one share of Series 2026 Preferred B stock as compensation for services provided to and debts settled on behalf of the Company. This stock is subject to a two-year restriction period.

### **NOTE 5 – SUBSEQUENT EVENTS**

The Company evaluated subsequent events through the date these unaudited consolidated financial statements were issued for events or transactions that occurred after March 31, 2026.

After March 31, 2026, Belisarian Holdings, LLC informed management that it had entered into a conversation with a party interested in purchasing its interest in the Company. A share purchase agreement has been exchanged and is not, as of the upload of this disclosure, signed. At this time, management is unable to speak to the likelihood of whether the ongoing conversation will result in a transaction, nor is management able to provide an estimated timeline for such a transaction's completion.
