**Letter of Introduction**

Mr. Vasilios,

With regard to the application of Molori Energy Inc. (Molori) to be included and traded on the OTCQB, Casimir Capital L.P. (Casimir), acting as a firm qualified to sponsor companies on the OTCQX, makes the following attestations:

1. Casimir is a U.S. registered broker-dealer and a member in good standing with FINRA. Casimir is not currently subject to any sanctions resulting from any disciplinary actions from any U.S. federal or state securities regulator, or from any self-regulatory organization that would prohibit or restrict his or her ability to serve as an Investment Bank PAL. Casimir has been approved by OTC Markets Group to serve as an Investment Bank PAL and is competent and able to serve and to exercise independent judgment as the Company's Investment Bank PAL without reservation.
2. Casimir has business relations with Joel Dumaresq, CEO of Molori Energy Inc. (Formerly Taipan Resources Inc.) for over 5 years.
3. Based on available information, the Casimir has a reasonable belief that the Company meets the following eligibility requirements for trading on the OTCQB:
  - Meet minimum bid price test of \$0.01
    - Molori is currently trading around CAD 0.19 with a 52 week low of CAD 0.06
  - Not be in bankruptcy
    - We believe Molori is not in bankruptcy and we have found no evidence to the contrary based on Molori filings with SEDAR
  - Be listed on a Qualified Foreign Exchange or be a U.S. Reporting Company (SEC, Regulation A or U.S. Bank)
    - Molori is currently listed on the TSX Venture Exchange, which is a Qualified Foreign Exchange
4. Based on available information, Casimir has a reasonable belief that Molori is in compliance with Exchange Act Rule 12g3-2(b) or, if Molori is not in compliance with Exchange Act Rule 12g3-2(b), Casimir has a reasonable belief that Molori is not required to register under Exchange Act Section 12(g) and is current and fully compliant with the obligations of a Company relying on the exemption from registration provided by Exchange Act Rule 12g3-2(b).
