Meanwhile, CCM focuses on managing patients' disease states to promote healthy habits and reduce hospital admissions.

MedHab, LLC, a wholly-owned St. Joseph company has signed a comprehensive agreement with CCHN to deliver both RPM and CCM services to nearly 5,000 patients across its 9 participating clinics. With a legacy spanning 50 years, CCHN is dedicated to providing exceptional medical services while prioritizing individualized care and support. Serving over 60,000 individuals annually, CCHN's mission is to improve lives by offering accessible, high-quality healthcare services to every community it serves.
